# Managers Notes

It wasn't long ago that we journeyed down to the coast to share the points and since then our visitors have had some good results and we know we will have to be at our best to get a place in the second round of what is in effect the Sussex FA Cup.

On Saturday we gained our second league win of the season in a game which saw 6 under 18s including 3 under 16s contribute to our win over Midhurst. Although the summer is over we are still suffering from a variety of player absence but this has given the young lads on the pathway a chance to show how bright the future is here at Roffey.

Last weekend, both of our Under 18 sides won with clean sheets meaning the weekend aggregate for our three matches was 8 goals for and none against.

We are also rather thin on the ground off the pitch tonight but I am sure we will all being doing our best to give you an enjoyable evening.

Saltdean United formed in 1966 by seven founding members who were inspired by the victorious England World Cup campaign. The club started life in the local Brighton Saturday League and gradually moved up their divisional structure over the years. Following the acquisition of their picturesque ground at Hill Park in the suburbs of Brighton, the club joined Division 3 of the Sussex County League in 1984/85, finishing third in their first season. More success followed and a promotion to Division 2 and senior football came in 1988/89 when Saltdean finished as champions. The next seven seasons were spent in this division, with the "Tigers" comfortably winning Division 2 in 1995/96 with games to spare. Promotion to Division 1 saw the clubhouse completely revamped and floodlights installed, the first Sussex County League club to invest in the impressive Musco system from the USA. The Tigers quickly established themselves as a force in the top division, finishing 4th in their inaugural season and reaching the final of the Sussex Senior Cup only to narrowly lose out to St. Leonards by the odd goal. In 1998/99 the club finished 2nd, and 3rd in 1999/2000 season when they also lifted the John O'Hara Cup, beating Burgess Hill Town after extra time in a thrilling match at Three Bridges. In 2002 the club suffered its first ever relegation to Division 2 and in 2007 were relegated again back to Division 3 where they remained for several years until 2011 when the club won the Sussex County League Division 3 Challenge Cup. A positive run in 2011/12 season saw the Tigers show their true spirit as they began the steady climb back up. As runners up in the league they were promoted back to Division 2 and lifted the Vernon Wentworth Cup. A difficult period followed, with several years spent in the lower half of Division 2 until the 2015/16 season when a change a of circumstances, interest and investment in the club brought a new lease of life to the Tigers. Led by a celebrated ex player with the support of local businessmen the club was transformed on and off the pitch. Within a single season Saltdean Utd went from bottom to top of the league gaining promotion back to the top flight of Sussex football in 2017 and in 2018/19 the Tigers were the proud winners of the Peter Bentley League Challenge Cup. In 2017 the Saltdean United Women's team were formed under the management of Joe McTiffen. The Women have gone from strength to strength and have enjoyed several promotions in a short period of time. As runners up of the Sussex Women's league in 2017/18, they were promoted to the South East Counties Premier Division. In 2018/19 as runners up in the league they were promoted to the London and South East Premier Division and were winners of the South East Counties Women's League Cup.

Into a new decade and the Men's First Team enjoyed a strong start to the 2020/21 season in the Southern Combination Football League Premier Division before the season was curtailed due to Covid-19. The 2021/22 season saw another strong finish for the Men's First Team as runners up in the league and the Sussex RUR Cup, missing out narrowly on both titles. Despite finishing second in the league, Saltdean missed out on promotion to step 4 due to not

The 2022/23 season saw a new young side put together under the management of Bradley Sweetman. The Tigers made a good start and held their own in a very difficult division for an inexperienced side. After hovering above the relegation places for most of the year, a difficult decision to relieve Brad of his duties was made, with Joe Mctiffen coming in to take the reins for the last six games, assisted by Paul Stokes. The Tigers finished the season by winning three, drawing one and losing the other two. This saw us comfortably confirm our place in the Premier division for another season after finishing six points clear from relegation. The Women's First team continued to impress in tier 5 after finishing joint fifth in a very competitive division. Competing against the likes of Fulham, Dartford, Millwall and Dulwich saw the Tigers only lose seven games all season. The Development Squad reached the league cup final, narrowly losing to Shoreham Ladies. The 2023/24 season saw Kieran Ridley begin his reign as the men's manager and although it was a difficult season, the men finished the campaign nine points clear of relegation. The women's section had a historic year with the 1st team reaching the 1st round proper of the FA cup, and the development squad winning a fantastic treble which saw them gain promotion in to tier 6. In what is now a very exciting year for the club which sees the legacy project in full swing. The brand new two storey clubhouse build has begun and we look forward to this being fully completed by April 2025 before a top of the range 3G surface is installed.


